## GRAMMAR

<b>PAST SIMPLE (Regular verbs)</b>	
The past simple is often <b>-ed</b> (regular verbs).	<b>BE CAREFUL!</b>
work - worked <u>ed</u> clean - cleaned <u>ed</u> start - started <u>ed</u> stay - stayed <u>ed</u> arrive - arrived <u>ed</u> dance – danced <u>ed</u> play - played <u>ed</u>	try - tried <u>ed</u> study - studied <u>ed</u> copy - copied <u>ed</u> stop - stop <u>ped</u> – it ends in c + v + c plan – plan <u>ned</u> – it ends in c + v + c
