start - start <u>ed</u>	study - stud <u>ied</u>	
stay - stay <u>ed</u>	copy - cop <u>ied</u>	
arrive - arrive <u>d</u>	stop - stopped – it ends in $c + v + c$	
dance – dance <u>d</u>	plan – plan <u>ned</u> – it ends in c + v + c	
play - play <u>ed</u>

Affirmative (-ed)	Negative (didn't)	Interrogative (Did)
I work <u>ed</u>	I didn't work	Did I work?
You work <u>ed</u>	You didn't work	Did you work?
He/She/It work <u>ed</u>	He/She/It didn't work	Did He/She/It work?
We work <u>ed</u>	We didn't work	Did we work?
You work <u>ed</u>	You didn't work	Did you work?
They work <u>ed</u>	They didn't work	Did they work?
